## Keypad Deadbolt

## How do I enter an access code to unlock the door with the keypad?

To unlock the door using the keypad, enter your fourdigit user code. When you see the Schlage button turn green, rotate the thumbturn toward the door's hinges.

If the Schlage button turns red, you have entered an incorrect user code. If it does not light up at all, you may have entered too many incorrect codes. Wait 30 seconds and try again.

#### How do I lock the deadbolt with the keypad?

To lock the door using the keypad, press the Schlage button and rotate the thumbturn away from the door's hinges. Depending on your host's settings, you may also need to enter the user code.

### How do I lock the deadbolt on the interior side of the door?

Simply rotate the thumbturn to lock and unlock the door from the inside.

## How do I light up the keypad to see the numbers at night?

If lighting is low, press the Schlage button at the top of the lock to illuminate the keypad.

#### Will the lock still work if the power goes out?

Yes. All Schlage smart locks are battery operated, so they will continue to work during a power outage.

## The Schlage button flashes red continuously. What does this mean?

The battery is dead. You will need to replace the battery immediately.

#### How do I change the battery?

Schlage<sup>®</sup> keypad deadbolt requires a new 9-volt alkaline battery, installed on the interior side of the lock.

To replace the battery:

- Remove the inside cover of the lock using a Phillips screwdriver to remove two screws – one each on the top and bottom of the lock.
- Replace the battery.
- Tuck the wires back inside the lock so that they are not crimped. Replace the cover, tightening both screws evenly.

#### **Icons and Lights**

- Flashing green Schlage button after entering a code: The code entered is correct.
- Flashing red Schlage button after entering a code: The code entered is incorrect.
- Continuous blinking red Schlage button: The battery is low.
